HOW TO REDUCE WASTE:



Use a reusable Drink bottle



Buy loose fruit and vegetables or use reusable produce bags



Compost food scraps at home



Put a 'No Junk Mail' sticker on your letter box



Drink your coffee at the cafe or use a reusable takeaway coffee cup



- Only purchasing what you can eat
- Planning your meals and using a shopping list
- Planning to use what is already in your pantry, fridge and freezer.
- Eating leftovers for lunch or freeze them for another night. If you don't like leftovers make smaller portions

Sip from the cup or bottle or carry a reusable straw with you



Purchase products made from recycled material i.e. buy toilet paper made from recycled paper



Take reusable bags with you

Use bubbles, flags or bunting instead of balloons

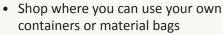


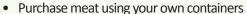
Store and freeze food in glass jars rather than plastic containers
