Regional Park

Quarry Hills preserves the imprint of geological events occurring around 400 million years ago. Ride your bike or walk the fantastic tracks and take in the views of the city and mountains. This is a unique park encompassing more than 220 hectares.

Plants and animals

Be on the lookout for birds of prey, bush birds, small mammals, shiny skinks and kangaroo's. There is also a lot of native vegetation to immerse yourself in. Be sure to take in the Granite Hills Walking Trail (via Topaz Grove) to view the amazing large granite boulders that are ideal for little climbers.
